

We would like to congratulate the HSC class of 2011 for their outstanding results.

Our 78 HSC students performed strongly across all curriculum areas:

This was reflected in the very high subject averages with all subjects scoring above 80%, while the following subjects achieved an average of over 90%:

Mathematics 3U, Mathematics 4U, History Extension, Geography, Music 1, Music 2, Music Extension, Dance, Drama

142 (34.47%) of all scripts written were awarded a Band 6 (scores of over 90%) which has ranked our School 24<sup>th</sup> out of all schools in NSW including the 47 Selective and partially Selective Schools in the state.

Five Reddam students were featured as "NSW Top All-Rounders"

In the creative and performing arts we had exceptional results:

The school came first in state for Dance

Two music students were nominated and selected for Encore
Two dance students were nominated and selected for Callback
Two Visual Arts students were nominated and selected for ArtExpress

In Mathematics Reddam House was placed amongst the top Independent schools with:

- 86.3% for Mathematics 2 Unit (with 38.59% of students achieving Band 6)
- 92.3% for Mathematics 3 Unit (with 81.25% of students achieving Band 6)
- 90.1 % Mathematics 4 Unit (with 57.14% of students achieving Band 6)

English likewise was ranked well with a school average of 86.8% in Advanced English.

In Chinese we had 3 students place in the top five in the state.

68 of our students were listed on the "Board of Studies HSC Distinguished Achiever's Honours Roll" having achieved Band 6 in at least 1 subject.

33% of the cohort achieved an ATAR of over 95.0 placing them in the top 5% of the state. 50% of the cohort achieved an ATAR of over 90.0 placing them in the top 10% of the state.


